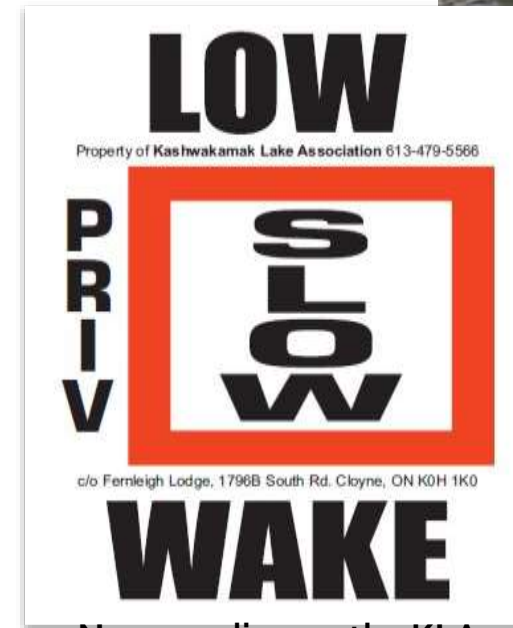


# Low Wake Markers “Information” Buoys



## *What does “Low Wake” mean?*

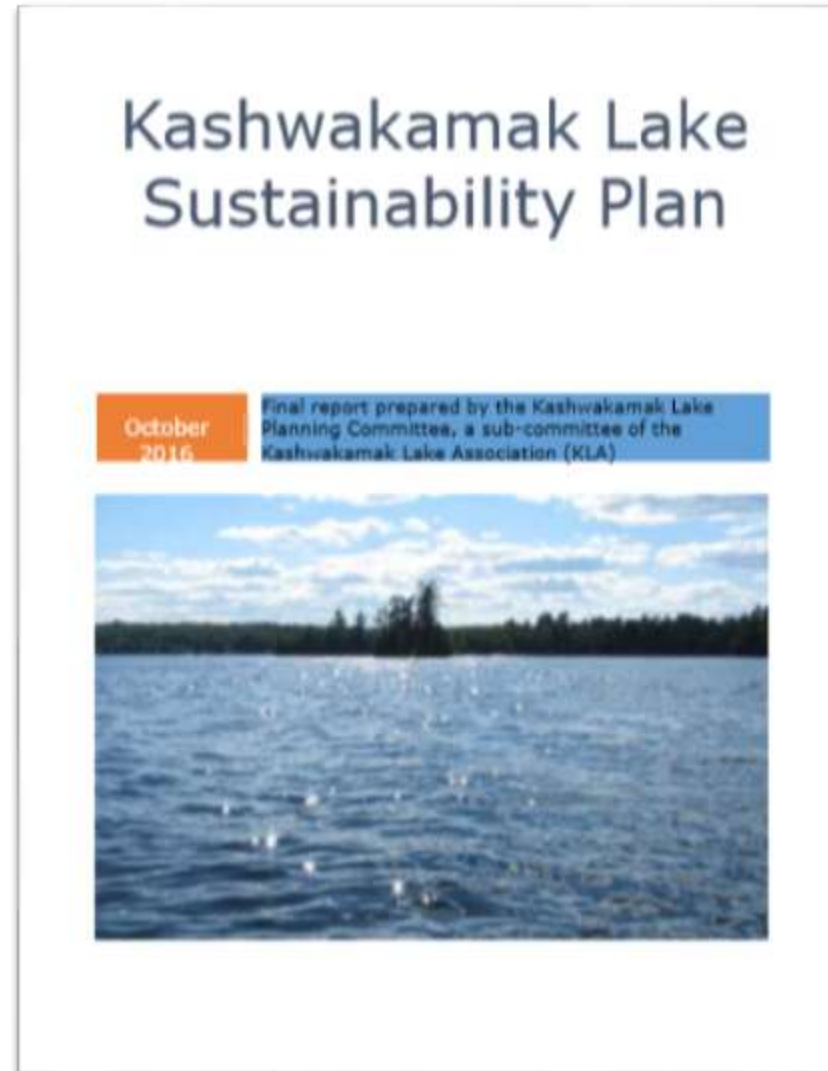
- A “Low Wake Zone” is a designated area where boats should make low or no waves.
- When you see a “Low Wake” it’s time to slow your motor boat or personal watercraft down to **10 km/hour or less** to ensure that little or no wake is produced.
- To do this, the engine must be put into **idle speed** when you’re entering the designated zone.
- Idle speed means the lowest speed a boat can safely operate while maintaining control of steering.
