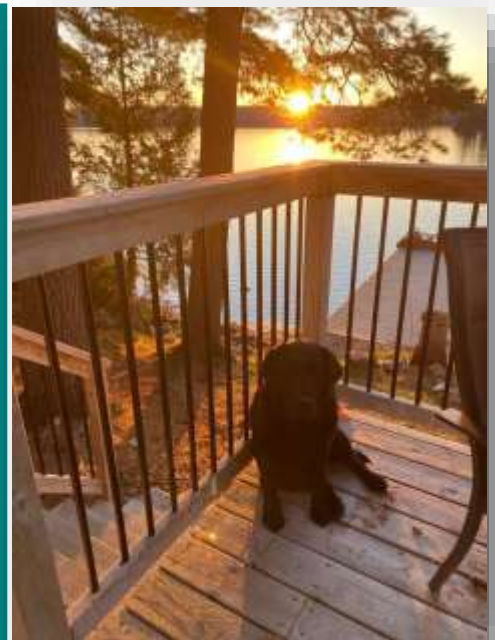

Membership options

The KLA has two types of memberships available:

We currently have **353** members (338 regular and 15 associate) in the Association. We gained 3 new members recently and had one come back from the outdated list. As usual, we try to get out all the relevant information we receive to our members in a timely manner.

Treasurer's Report - Judy McIntyre

Financial statements

Copies of the December 31, 2020 financial statements are available on our website in the member section. The December 31, 2019 statements are available as well. Since there was no AGM in 2019 we will have 2 years of financials to approve at the 2021 virtual AGM. These statements are currently under review by two KLA volunteers. Thank you to Sue Barchard and Laurie Martin for stepping up to review the books on behalf of the KLA membership! Please review the financial statements which are online under the Members' portal of our website. Let me know if you have any questions about them.

Membership revenue

Membership revenue for 2020 was \$5,025, which looks significantly higher than 2019 revenue of \$4,185. In 2019 we did an extensive cleanup and wrote off many old accounts. Beginning in 2020, these adjustments are shown in separate line items on the income statement. The good news is that the membership list is very clean now, and receivables are being collected in a timely fashion, so there shouldn't be any old account adjustments of any significance going forward.

Paying your dues

E-transfers continue to be a huge timesaver, so special thanks to those that send their membership dues that way. And special thanks to the South Side Road Association (SSRA) who sent dues for all of their members in very early this year! It's wonderful to get these dues early, during cooler weather,

so that I can enjoy the summer weather with less time on the computer!


There are still some unpaid 2020 membership dues, so if you are unsure of your account status please contact me and I will be happy to let you know your current status. Just a reminder that cottagers who are members of the South Shore Road Association, Silver Mine Road Association and the Kashwakamak Cottage Association pay their KLA dues through their road associations.

Advertising revenue

At May 5, 2020 we have roughly \$9,500 in the bank. Debbi Leith took on the task of soliciting advertising for the 2021 newsletters. She has run a very successful ad campaign and has raised \$3,300 to date. Thanks to Debbi for taking on this volunteer role and making it such a huge success! 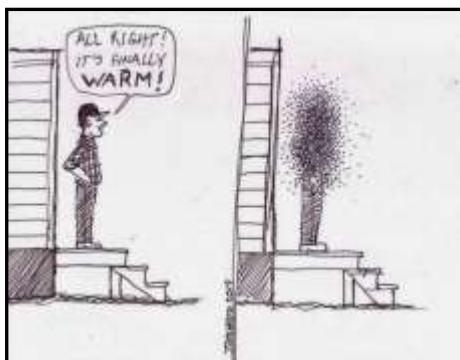
Lake Steward's Report - Peter Johnson

Springtime is here again on Kash. There is no better place to be. I hope everyone weathered the winter okay. I certainly got to know the local snowmobile trails better.

The ice was off this spring on April 6th which was a week or two earlier than past years. Water levels remained low for most of the spring due to low precipitation and snow melt but it has recently recovered to normal summer levels. Fall Dinner and Charity Auction Cancelled

The Board also decided to cancel the fall dinner and charity auction due to the on-going pandemic and uncertainty around Public Health guidance for indoor events. 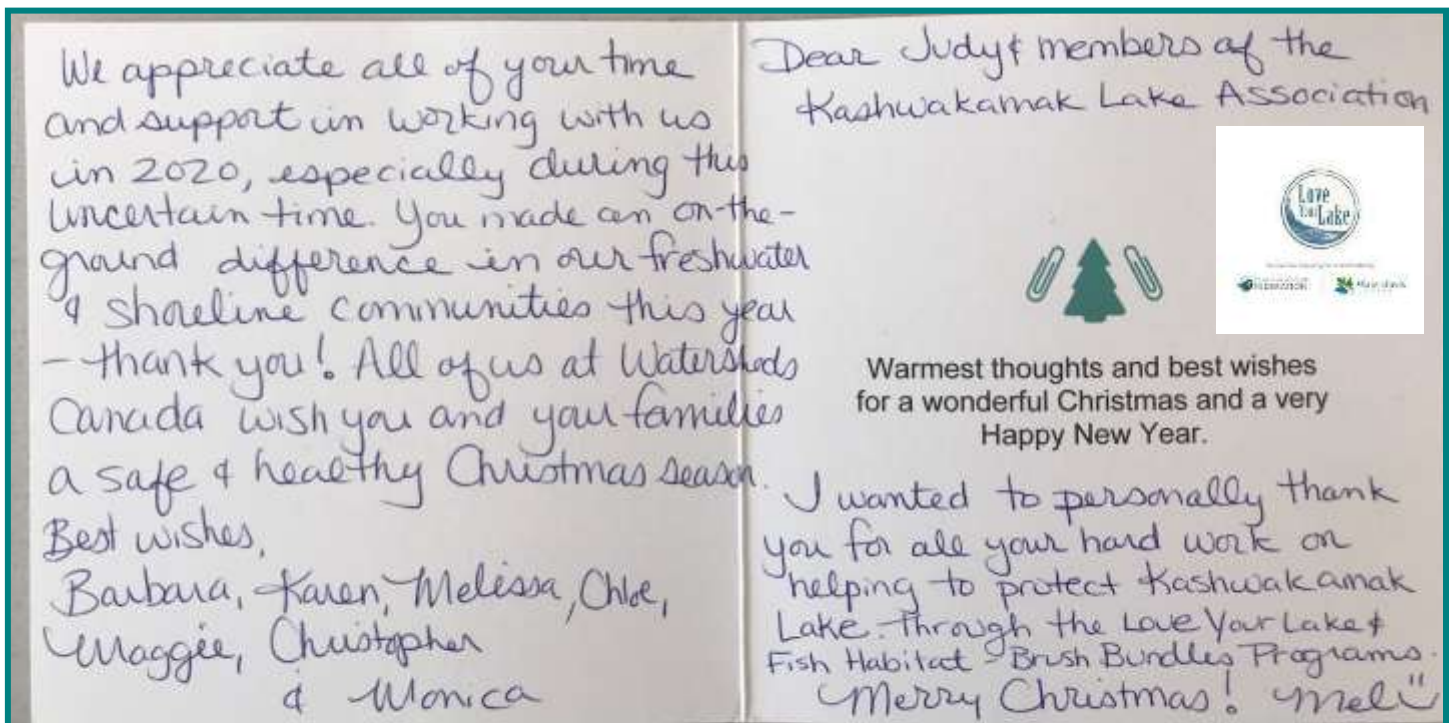

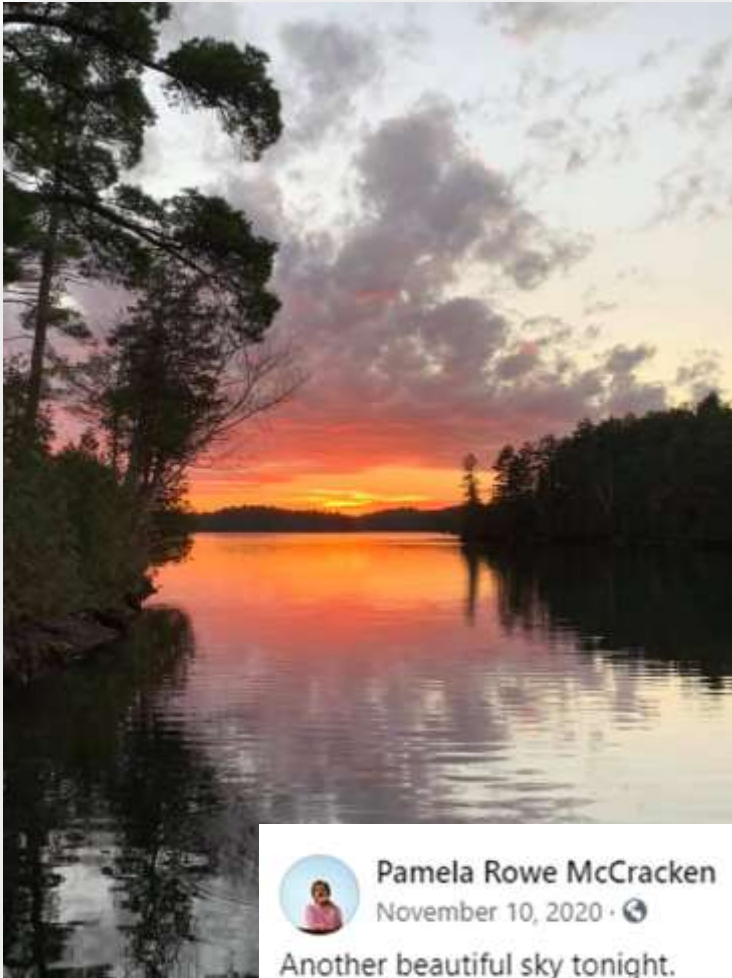

Be as detailed as possible when writing down the location! This will be used when releasing the turtle to its home wetland area if it has recovered.
- 3 CALL THE OTCC 705 744 5000**
We are open 8am-8pm.
Our Turtle Coordinators are able to take calls and our Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians staff are ready to help!
- 4 DRIVE THE TURTLE (OR WAIT FOR ITS AIDE)**
We have first responders across the province that can stabilize a turtle with medications and supplies!
We have turtle rescue volunteers ready to drive the turtle to get the help it needs!

DECEASED TURTLE? WE WANT IT!
It is really hard to tell when a turtle is deceased. Our first responders are well equipped with **resuscitation** and other supplies to assess their potential for recovery. **WANT? EGGS, TISSUE SAMPLES, DATA COLLECTION, CONSERVATION, EDUCATION!**

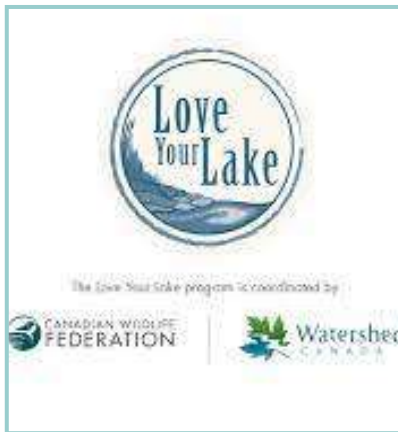
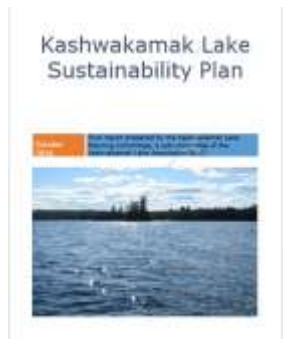

Lake Sustainability Implementation Update

Shoreline & Water Quality sub-committee - *Love Your Lake*

As you will recall, following the 2016 membership approval of the [Kashwakamak Lake Sustainability Plan](#), actions are being taken to maintain and enhance the lake water quality and shoreline. Part of the action plan included shoreline tree and shrub planting in 2018 as part of the [Natural Edge Program](#). In 2020, the KLA began implementing another recommendation from the plan, the [Love Your Lake](#) initiative, which assesses each shoreline property and makes voluntary recommendations for maintaining, enhancing or restoring the shoreline.



Under the direction of [Watersheds Canada](#), the *Love Your Lake* assessments were completed on our lake last July. In all, over 670 properties were assessed on our lake! Property owners were contacted by Watersheds Canada in April and have access to their personal waterfront assessments and recommendations on-line for free, or a printed copy for \$20. These reports are confidential.

The KLA Board is still waiting to receive the overview report, without identifying information, regarding the state of the lake in general. We will post it on our website once we receive it. Plan to attend our virtual AGM on July 14th to see the overview presentation by Watersheds Canada. There will be a question and answer period at the end, but they won't be specific to anyone's property.

The KLA's Lake Sustainability Implementation sub-committee on Water Quality, Shoreline Protection & Health will review the report and make recommendations to the board on specific actions or projects we might want to undertake. Stay tuned for volunteer opportunities! Many thanks to Peter Burbidge for his on-going coordination of the Love Your Lake program. We really appreciate his efforts!

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
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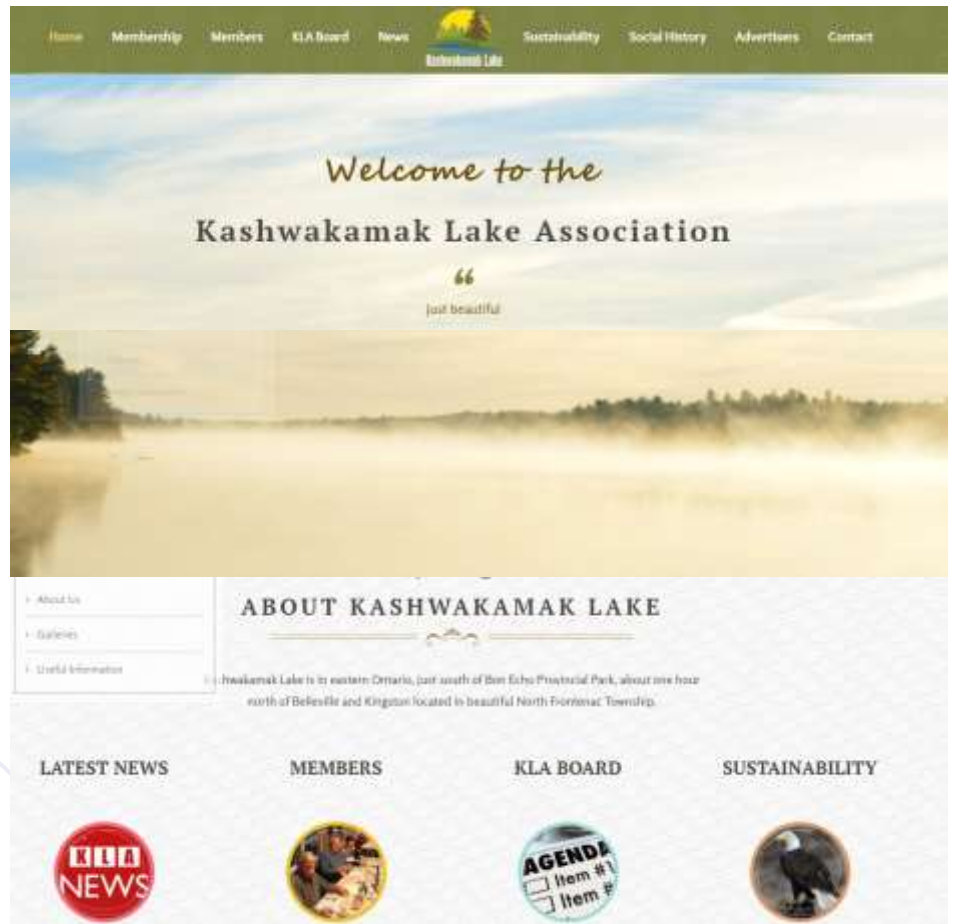
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
